Policy Statement on Conflict Minerals

The enactment of U.S. Congress HR 4173, specifically with regard to section 1502-Conflict Minerals, addresses serious issues and concerns within the supply chain for raw materials. Section 1502 prohibits the use of "Conflict Minerals" in manufactured goods. Spectrum is committed to supporting government and industry initiatives to avoid the use of minerals mined in areas where mining activities fuel conflict.

Spectrum procures printed wiring boards with gold and tin-alloy finishes and tin-alloy solder used during in-house soldering operations. Spectrum will continue to undertake reasonable due diligence within our supply chain to assure that gold and tin-alloy metals are not procured as Conflict Minerals.

Spectrum is committed to sourcing minerals responsibly and considers mining activities that fuel conflict as unacceptable.
